Indoor Targets

The indoor backstops have been rotated. We have been asked to remind our members of the following items.

- Spread your "spots" around the entire target area, this decreases the wear on the center of our targets
- Hang cardboard prior to shooting the indoor targets. If the cardboard is shot out please hang new cardboard. Cardboard is located at the east end of the lane, just open the carpeted door.
- There have been instances of members using the target pins for targets. These are not to be used as targets. They may look simple and cheap but they are not, in fact the cost of one pin is over .60 cents apiece. Anyone noticing any member shooting these pins are asked to give the members name to Larry McNew.
- The indoor 3-D targets are for **league shooting only**. Please do **not** use them for practice.
